# 2020 PMB Open to be played at Victoria Country Club on Sunday 11 October 2020

## Information & Conditions

### **1. Format:**

36 Holes strokeplay held in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and Local Rules approved by the Committee on Sunday 11 October 2020. Entries close: Wednesday 7 October 2020 at 12h00.

### **2. Registration:**

Registration will take place on the day from 06h30. All players are required to report to the tournament registration table prior to play.

### **3. Practice Rounds:**

Competitors wishing to play a practice round during the week prior to the event can do so by contacting the club on 033 347 1394. This is subject to availability and at a cost of R 220 per round for adults and R 160 for students/juniors.

### **4. Motorised Carts:**

Golf carts will not be permitted.

### **5. Caddies:**

Caddies are available and are allocated on a first come first served basis. Players may bring their own caddies.

### **6. The field will be limited to a field size of 90 players. Should entries exceed the field size, preference will be given to Order of Merit players, thereafter to the lowest handicapped golfers. Should the entry allow for divisions, A Division will be for players with a handicap index of 5.1 or less. B Division will be from 5.2.**

The Committee has the right to refuse any entry without giving the reason for the refusal. The decision of the Committee as to the acceptance or refusal of any entry shall be final.

### **7. The Committee reserves the right to alter the advertised times of starting times.**

### **8. The draw will be available from 08h00 on Thursday 8 October. Players shall start at the time laid down by the tournament committee.**

### **9. Anti-Doping Policy:** All competitors are subject to the provisions of the International Golf Federation's Anti-Doping Policy. Detail of the policy and the current prohibited substances and methods are available from the International Golfing Federation's website: [www.internationalgolfederation.org](http://www.internationalgolfederation.org).

Competitors who are taking medication and are in doubt as to their clinical status should seek advice from SAGA not later than 30 days before the start of the tournament. Random testing may take place.

### Covid-19 RMG

The following protocols are applicable for all persons using the facilities at Victoria Country Club during current Level 3 Restrictions as set out by

- The legislative requirements issued under the Disaster Management Act, 57 of 2002 and the regulations issued in terms of Section 27(2) of said Act, which regulations may change from time to time.

#### Player screening:

Victoria Country Club uses the **HealthDocs** App to comply with the required contact tracing legislation. All persons visiting the facility are required to have downloaded and registered on the **HealthDocs** system. Screening and the measuring of temperatures will be done prior to registration.

#### Social Distancing & Face Masks:

The wearing of face masks around and inside the club house is compulsory. If social distancing of less than 3 metres is not possible, face masks must be worn in all other areas.

#### Club house facilities:

The change rooms and showers will be closed.

#### Player sanitizing:

Sanitizing stations are set up at the entrances to the caddy hut, pro shop, halfway house, bar and inside the ablution facilities.

Players using caddies are required to get their bags sanitized prior to and after the round.

All players are required to have their own sanitizer for use on the golf course.
